- Nearly 400 Rotarians in the Tri-Cities will sell over 25,000 duck tickets between July and September 14<sup>th</sup> of this year. The top prize in 2024 will be a new vehicle donated by Toyota and Toyota of Tri-Cities. Make/Model will be revealed soon!
- Nearly 50 other prizes are donated by local businesses (many are Rotarians) and given to race winners. Each prize, donor and prize value is printed on the back of each ticket providing donors excellent positive public visibility. Prize donors are recognized on social media and the duck race website (tcduckrace.com)
- All net proceeds from the race are distributed through local Tri-Cities Rotary to their chosen not-for-profit charities, humanitarian efforts, and service organizations – some examples of recipients in the past include High School Student Scholarships, Columbia Industries, ARC of Tri-Cities, Grace Clinic, Boys and Girls Club, Reading Foundation of the Mid-Columbia, Project Warm Up, Washington Operation Thank You, Scouts BSA, and many more!
